Trooper 2 Memorial

Since shortly after the tragic crash of Trooper 2, in 2008, a small group of dedicated volunteers have been working with the families of the crash victims to plan an appropriate tribute to the dedication and courage of the first responders, and to the accident victims who perished that day.

The planned memorial will be located in Walker Mill Park at the entrance to the walking trail leading to the crash location. A second marker will be placed at the actual crash site.

Tragedy strikes Trooper 2

On September 27th, 2008, Trooper 2 responded to Waldorf, Maryland to assist Waldorf Fire Department with a motor vehicle crash. Working alongside first responders, two patients were identified for transport. A second medical provider would be required to assist with patient care in the helicopter.

Trooper 2 encountered poor weather while attempting to deliver the patients to a trauma center, and diverted to the closest airport. The helicopter would crash on approach to Andrews Air Force Base. The flight crew, one patient and the second medical provider were killed in the crash. One patient survived the crash, and was located, treated, and transported by rescuers.

The Maryland State Police Aviation Command was established in 1961 to provide airborne law enforcement, and aerial search and rescue support for the **Maryland State Police**, and allied law enforcement agencies in Maryland, and its neighbors. Since then their missions have included routine traffic patrol, monitoring of special events, surveillance of criminal activity, and tracking of escapees and suspects. Today the Aviation Command performs five separate mission profiles using the same aircraft and crew: medevac, aerial law enforcement, search and rescue, homeland security, and disaster assessment.
